CIRCLE Group: Digitalisation, Simplification and Interoperability in the Transfer of Goods between a Port Area and an Inland Area in a Simplified Logistics Zone

Genova, April 10, 2025

<u>Circle S.p.A.</u> ("CIRCLE" or the "Company") - an Innovative SME listed on the Euronext Growth Milan market, heading the Group specialized in the process analysis and the development of solutions for the digitalization of the port and intermodal logistics sectors, as well as in the international consultancy on Green Deal and energy transition topics – is pleased to announce its involvement in the project 'Automated Systems and Al Tools for Optimal Management of Port Traffic Flows', developed within Spoke 4 in the RAISE - Robotics and Al for Socio-economic Empowerment, together with Aitek.

As part of these activities, the pilot project is being created with the aim of developing technological solutions to facilitate the exchange of goods between the port of disembarkation and the various intermodal areas of the **Simplified Logistics Zone (ZLS)**, it has been expanded the collaboration between several key players in the logistics sector, including the **Liguria Region** in primis, the **Customs Agency**, **shippers**, **agents**, **terminal operators**, **logistics players** and other stakeholders, with the aim of demonstrating the operational readiness of the **ZLS coordinated precisely by the Liguria Region**. The project focuses on the adoption of **federated**, **digital**, **interoperable** tools aimed at improving the efficiency and fluidity of freight traffic flows.

The **pilot project** aims to optimize logistics processes through an advanced digital platform that manages, monitors and tracks every stage of the cargo transfer in real time: thanks to automated checks and instant notifications, it ensures safety and regulatory compliance, while also allowing the export of data for administrative and customs management. The system further simplifies transfer operations with automatic alerts, improving the efficiency and smoothness of port operations.

The sustainable approach helps reduce emissions and congestion, improving the competitiveness of the port and the quality of services offered, with a positive impact on the attractiveness of the service, increased port traffic and local economic growth.

Another key component of the system is the interface with customs offices, which allows them to monitor the status of transfers and access the accompanying documentation of goods in real time. Furthermore, the possible activation of tools such as the **Customs Free Zone (FTZ) and the S.U.DO.CO**. system at local level would allow the sharing of information with the customs offices involved, further improving the efficiency and transparency of operations, reducing waiting times at critical junctions and checkpoints, containing operating costs and decreasing emissions and traffic congestion.

The implementation of the ZLS not only optimises logistics efficiency, but also offers important benefits to businesses, **including tax incentives on investments**, **simplified administrative procedures and digitised customs procedures**.

The Simplified Logistics Zone (ZLS) in Liguria, whose first guidelines will be announced by the end of April, complies with the specific legal requirements and is expected to evolve rapidly.

On the occasion of the event 'ZES/ZLS: opportunities for enterprises', held on March 25, 2025 in Genoa, firstly Jacopo Riccardi, Head of Regione Liguria and then Giampaolo Botta, General Manager of SPEDIPORTO, anticipated the start of a collaboration with the Customs Agency and Circle Group aimed at activating an experimental corridor to strengthen the connection between the port areas and the ZLSs, with benefits for the Genoese and regional context and for the entire Made in Italy industry.

On that occasion, **Emanuele Profice, head of the Genoa AdSP's European policies office**, highlighted how the ZLS fosters synergy between the port, the city, and the back port, driving demand for new shippers and investors in the port.

On 28th March in Confindustria and on 31 March at the Spediporto Assembly, a













number of further important and concrete innovations emerged.

Alessio Piana, Liguria Region, adds: 'The Simplified Logistic Zone will be a very important economic acceleration tool for the companies insisting on our territory and the entire North-West. We are very pleased that, in the context of Raise, we have managed to intercept a project that aims to improve, through digitalisation, the flow of goods to and from our ports'.

'The experimentation started by Circle represents an important result of the research, development and innovation activities of RAISE's Spoke 4, where technologies based on robotics and artificial intelligence applied to ports and, more generally, to the Blue Economy sectors are being developed; I am very satisfied that all the efforts made over the last 3 years can be repaid by valuable results and products,' says **Davide Giglio**, Professor of Transport at the University of Genoa and Spoke 4 coordinator.

'The adoption of this system represents an important step in which the efficient management of customs and logistics procedures plays a fundamental role in the development of an advanced logistics ecosystem, capable of attracting new investments and enhancing the territory's competitiveness,' says **Luca Abatello**, CEO of Circle Group. 'We are developing concrete cases in collaboration with RAISE, the Liguria Region, the Customs Agency and stakeholders in the perspective of progressively making available concrete tools for simplification and innovation. We will continue to engage in the development of federated solutions to improve interoperability between different systems, helping to create a more collaborative and synchronous working environment in the port logistics sector by pursuing the objectives of the 'Connect 4 Agile Growth' business plan.'
