CIRCLE GROUP at the heart of eFTI evolution: Luca Abatello speaks at the MIT and RAM national event dedicated to the progressive implementation of the European Regulation

The President presents the experiences, benefits, and next steps of the eFTI4EU Pilot and confirms the Group's role in major European logistics digitization projects

During the proceedings, Luca Abatello, President and CEO of Circle Group, will speak on "The eFTI4EU project pilots: experiences, benefits, and next steps." The focus is on sharing the results achieved during the testing phase, the concrete impact on freight transport processes, and the operational prospects in view of the entry into force of the obligation to use digital data provided for by Regulation (EU) 2020/1056.

In recent years, Circle Group has strengthened its presence in European programs dedicated to the evolution of the eFTI ecosystem, participating not only in the eFTI4EU and eFTI4ALL projects, but also in the more recent eFTI4LIVE, where (also through Magellan Circle Italia) it contributes to the development and dissemination of interoperable digital platforms that will form the reference infrastructure for European freight transport. The experience gained by the Group is also part of a broader process that includes innovation and digitalization activities carried out thanks to the enhancement of the Milos® technological ecosystem, the growth of air cargo solutions with Cargo Start, the commitment to advanced infomobility services with eXyond, and the consolidation of the collaborative transport document management model guaranteed by the ACCUDIRE platform.



During his speech, Luca Abatello illustrated how the eFTI4EU pilots, carried out in collaboration with MIT and RAM, made it possible to test the use of digital data to replace paper documentation in real, multimodal scenarios, highlighting significant benefits such as reduced verification times, improved traceability, greater transparency of operations, and simplified inspection activities for the competent authorities. Abatello also previewed the next steps that will see Circle Group engaged in the platform validation phase, in structured dialogue with Member States, and in new application scenarios that will expand the scope of experimentation in various transport segments.

The event was also attended by the confederations and associations that participated in the working groups, the actors who participated in the pilot projects, and the supervisory authorities, as well as a number of companies interested in the evolution of the regulation and the digitization of transport documents and controls.

"The digital transformation of European freight transport," comments Luca Abatello, President and CEO of Circle Group, "is now a reality and no longer a future prospect. The pilots developed with eFTI4EU demonstrate how interoperability, common datasets and standards, and the full use of digital data can generate immediate benefits for businesses, operators, and authorities. Circle Group is proud to contribute to this process with its technological expertise, design capabilities, and a European vision shared with all our partners."

Participation in the event further confirms Circle Group's leading role in strategic projects driving the digital transition of logistics and transport, in line with European priorities and the development guidelines of the "Connect 4 Agile Growth" industrial plan.
